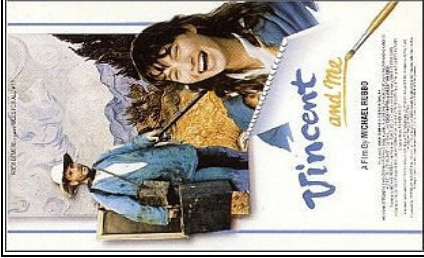

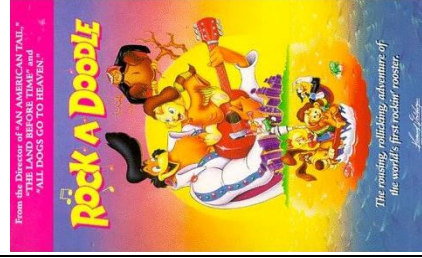


June 11th @ 6PM Vincent and Me

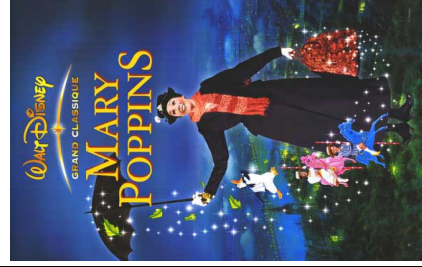


June 18th @ 6PM Night at the Museum

Chanticleer is a golden-tongued rooster who misses the arrival of the sun one morning and leaves the farm in disgrace to make his name in the big city. When Edmond tries to evoke Chanticleer to bring the sun back, the duke turns him into a kitten, transporting him into the animated world of the rooster and the other animals from his book. Thus begins a colorful journey filled with songs and adventure. *Rated G – 74 minutes*



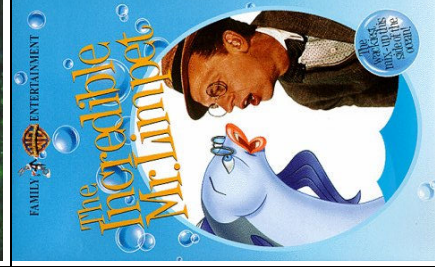
July 2nd @ 6PM Mary Poppins
